Alice Rostov Bordy passed away on February 13, 2019, in Kansas City, Missouri. She served on the board of the local chapter of the American Diabetes Society and Jewish Vocational Services with Marvin. She was a Girl Scout leader and a Cub Scout den leader. She was a member of Beth Shalom Synagogue and regularly attended Shabbat services with her wonderful group of friends. She was a lifelong learner. Her hobbies were knitting, playing bridge, reading and genealogy.

Alice loved celebrating holiday and events with her family and celebrated her 90th birthday in 2017 with more than 100 of her family and friends.
