Beverly Mae Fishman, 83, of Overland Park, KS, passed away peacefully surrounded by her family on Sunday, February 5, 2012 at Village Shalom. Funeral services will be at 12 noon Tuesday, February 7, at The Louis Memorial Chapel, 6830 Troost Avenue, Kansas City, MO with burial to follow at Kehilath Israel Blue Ridge Cemetery.
