Herbert "Herby" Brooks, 87, of Overland Park, KS, passed away Monday, December 5, 2011 at Menorah Medical Center. Funeral services will be at 2:30pm Wednesday, December 7, at The Louis Memorial Chapel, 6830 Troost Avenue, Kansas City, MO 64131 with burial to follow at Kehilath Israel Blue Ridge Cemetery.
