Maury J. Rydell of Overland Park, Kansas, passed away on October 15, 2017 at Menorah Medical Center surrounded by his loving family. Graveside services will be Tuesday, October 17th at Mount Carmel Cemetery at 11:00 am.

Maury was born in Zagorze, Poland to the late Shimon and Rachel Rydelnik. His family moved to Bedzin, Poland. Maury survived four concentration camps during the Holocaust by sewing uniforms for the Nazis in the Rosner Factory. In 1945, Maury moved to Marktoberdorf, Germany then two years later moved to Munich with his brother and sisters. In 1949, Maury moved to New York City working in Brooklyn at Grossman Clothing Store doing alterations. Kansas City became Maury's home where he and his wife, Eva, raised their family. He became a citizen of the United States. Working at Fashionbilt Garment Company for over 30 years, he started as a machine operator and was soon promoted to a quality control manager. While watching the news, sports and live concerts on TV all night long, he also kept up with his grandchildren and extended family's sports, travels and activities. Maury loved his family.

Maury is preceded in death by his sisters, Cesia, Hanna Sukiennik, Jean Saionz and brothers Jolek and Milton. He is survived by his wife of nearly 60 years Eva, son and daughter-in-law: Gary and Marcy Rydell of Overland Park, KS, daughter and son-in-law Suzy and Steve Weinstein of St. Louis, MO.; He adored his 5 grandchildren: Adam, Alyssa, Kaity Rydell and Jake and Alexa Weinstein; Nieces and nephews: Simon (Lynne) Saionz, Carol Rydell (Gary Langston), Jana (Sam) Fisherowitz, Valerie (Mark) Gerstein, lan (Wendy) Snitz and numerous loving family members worldwide.
