July 13, 1912 - April 29, 2019

After 106 years, Father Time and Mother Nature finally caught up with Sarah B. Zeldin. Funeral services will be at 10:30am Thursday, May 2, 2019 at The Louis Memorial Chapel with burial to follow at Sheffield Cemetery. She was born July 13, 1912 in Kansas City, MO the daughter of Joseph and Rose (Kahn) Kaufman and was a lifelong area resident.

Mrs. Zeldin was a member of Beth Israel Abraham and Voliner Synagogue, of which she was the last founding member, and its Sisterhood. She was a BIAV Woman of the year and was a past chairman of the Gift Shop.
